Undergraduate nondegree students who subsequently wish to apply for degree study must file additional application documents and be accepted o for degree study. Since the mere accumulation of courses will not satisfy degree requirements, one should consult the appropriate dean or departm chair before enrolling. A nondegree-seeking student may take up to nine credits, which may be counted toward degree requirements if full acceptar a degree program is granted.
